- Support for recruitment and portfolio planning (with your Marketing teams)

- Support for development and internal approval of collaborative student education programmes / agreements / contracts
- Always seek International team help BEFORE talking to potential partners in detail about Joint and Dual degrees, articulations (2+2, 3+1), progression agreements (1+1 etc).
- Support for recruitment and partner development visits overseas
 - Country market briefings
 - Market intelligence relating to recruitment and partner networks



- Market intelligence from your home country regarding HE institutions, qualifications, funding opportunities
- Your experiences of teaching and researching globally
- Partnership opportunities, contacts and networks
- Links based on joint posts, visiting professorships, academic exchange
- Travel plans if shared early, we may be able to suggest useful additional recruitment or partnership activity
